Three Brothers Killed in Action.

THEY were sons of Mr. and Mrs. G. E. Donglas, of Bridge-street, Erskineville, Sydney. Settle of Gordon L. Douglas, 17th Battalion, was the eldest son (28 years and three months). The little of the little in action in France or, 15th April, 1917. Corporal Alan E. Donglas, 20th Battalion (26 years and seven months), was killed at Pozieres on 26th July, 1916. Private Kenneth G. Douglas, 17th Battalion (19 years and eight months), was killed on 20th September, 1917. There is one other son, aged 17, years, who is very eager to enlist, but is too young. Private Kenneth left with the reinforcements to the 35th Battalion, but was transferred to the 17th Battalion to be with his relies brother, who, however, was killed just two days before Kenneth joined up with the 17th. Contract Alan Douglas was at Gallipoli, and took part in the evacuation.
