



I have been verbally informed that an ex employe of this Department (Charles Woolley) who was granted extended leave without pay on 25-3-16 to take service with the Expeditionary Forces was killed on active service and I would be glad if you can advise me if this is correct. My records show his date of birth as 30-5-83 and his next of kin - Mrs Hancock (mother), Condon Street, Kennington, Bendigo. Before leaving Australia he advised he was attached to the 10th Machine Gun Company, 10th Brigade, Port Melbourne Rifle Range Camp.


