
INSTRUCTIONS TO BE OBSERVED IN THE COMPILATION AND USE OF FILES.

- 1. When opening a new file, care must be taken to see that a file dealing with the subject is not already in existence and covers should be completed with details for which space is provided.
- 2. Cord laces only must be used to hold papers in file cover.
- 3. Minute Sheets to be attached to the left-hand inside cover and enclosures to the right-hand side.
- 4. Minute Sheets are to be used for correspondence within the Department. Correspondence from and to outside bodies is to appear as an enclosure and a brief summary of every enclosure is to be included in the minute which gives the enclosure its number and makes it part of the file. If the enclosure is in one part, its number will be followed by the letter "A," subsequent parts being lettered "B," "C," "D," etc.
- 5. Minute number one is to be on the printed side of the Minute Sheet and is to face the cover on the minute side of the file.
- 6. Correspondence on subjects on which a file already exists must not be made on loose Minute Sheets—the file must be obtained and action taken thereon.
- 7. Minutes must be added in numerical order and both sides of the Minute Sheets are to be used.
- 8. Files must not be passed between Branches by hand without transit slips.
- 9. Notes of action taken may be entered on the Minute Sheets, otherwise unaddressed minutes will not be made.
- 10. Minutes may be noted by Officers placing their initials over the reference to them at the minute head and such words as "agree" and "concur" may be used to obviate separate minutes by individual addressees. An Officer's initials so placed will indicate concurrence with the minute.
- 11. In Column 1 on the cover is to be indicated the persons for whom minutes or enclosures are intended, the number of that minute or enclosure and the date it is passed out from the last person noting (or otherwise using) the file being indicated in columns 2 and 3, respectively.
- 12. When the person indicated in column I has taken the necessary action on the file, he (or his representative) will draw a line through the reference to him in columns I, 2 and 3 on the cover and will place his initials in column 4, indicating that the necessary action has been taken. He will then indicate on the next line to whom the file is to pass—completing columns 2 and 3.

CIRCUMSTANTIAL REPORT INTO FLYING ACCIDENT TO SUNDERLAND EK. 578 ON 16TH SEPTEMBER, 1943

Sir,

I have the honour to submit the following circumstantial report on the above accident, our signal P.326 dayed 17th Sept, 1943 refers.

- At 1542 hours on the 16th of September, 1943 while on A nti Submarine Patrol in the Bay of Biscay, Sunderland Ek.578 was engaged by six JU 88*s. In the resulting combat, in which all turrets were put out of action except for one gun the mid upper turret, the Sunderland was forced into the sea due to the fact that three engines had been hit.
- The nose gunner was hit in the leg by cannon shell in the early part of the engagement. On landing in the sea the crew took to the dinghies, two of which sank due to being riddled by cannon shrapnel and after being located by a Catalina of No. 210 Squadron were picked up and by the Second Escort Group and all landed at Milford Haven with the exception of AUS.16530 Sergeant BAMBER K FMA/AG who was taken on and admitted to R.A.F. Hospital West Kirby. He is suffering from shrapnel wounds in the legs and exposure but according to a report received from R.A. F Hospital West Kirby, in a few days should be well enough to go on sick leave.



This letter is to confirm the telegram from this Department dated the 20th September, 1943, informing you that your son, Flying Officer Ivor Wivian Ross Peatty, was reported missing for a short period on the 16th September, 1943, but is now reported safe. The despatch of this letter has been held in this Department pending the receipt of full details from the Air Ministry, London. I now desire to inform you that your son was a member of the crew of a Sunderland aircraft which was attacked a member of the crew of a Sunderland alrerart which was attacked by six enemy aircraft while engaged on an anti-submarine patrol on the date mentioned above. The ensuing engagement lasted one hour and forty-five minutes, and your son's aircraft was seen to go into the sea by the crew of another aircraft. I am pleased to inform you, however, that all members of the crew were rescued by a naval sloop, and arrived in the United Kingdom on September 21st, 1943. One member of the crew was injured, and upon arrival in the United Kingdom he was admitted to hospital, but his condition is not serious. hospital, but his condition is not serious.
