Note: In 1987 that portion of the Presbyterian Cemetery lying adjacent to Moore Street was resumed to allow for widening of the road to become the Moore-Oxley Bypass. The Department of Main Roads compiled a register of all persons buried in the affected area and contacted those descendants who were able to be located. In March 1987, graves and/or memorial stones were moved to other locations within the cemetery or other cemeteries. A memorial plaque for George Byram is now located on the family plot in St Peters Anglican Church Cemetery.
