Ivor Hele's portrait "Bardia (action leading to the fall of Post 11)".

The action was on 3 January 1941 and the portrait shows Australian and Italian living and dead. The Australians are members of the 2/6th Infantry Battalion.

Ivor Hele wrote: 'I have taken the incident where Brockley is lifting Joe [sic] to his feet, with Bernie Damm carrying his brother + Maloney keeping the enemy heads down in the background, with Cpl Latham dead near Joe's [sic] feet.'
