In reply to your letter regarding the award of the Military Medal, following is a copy of the citation that accompanied the award :


AWARD OF THE MILITARY MEDAL

"Near LOUVERVAL, during the operations between 8th and 15th April 1917, Pte MARKS rendered valuable service by carrying important messages under most trying and dangerous circumstances as a Company Runner. He displayed great bravery and devotion to duty throughout this period.

Enemy barrages and machine gun and rifle fire were treated by him with contempt. His indefatigable energy and extreme bravery enabled him to perform valuable service".

The above was promulgated in the Fourth Supplement No 30135 to the London Gazette dated 15th June, 1917, and the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette No 169 of 4th October, 1917.
