With reference to your application for acceptance of Septic Tonsils and Sinusitis,

as due to war service, I have to advise that, after investigation, the following diagnosis was made:—
Tonsillitis, Sinusitis and Malaria.

These disabilities have been accepted as being due to your war service but, as there is no assessable degree of incapacity therefrom, no pension will be paid at present in respect of such disabilities.

With regard to the pension aspect, you may, at any time within three months after the date of this advice, appeal to an Assessment Appeal Tribunal. The necessary form of appeal is obtainable at this office on receipt of a letter or personal application.

Medical treatment for the above may be obtained in future at the expense of the Commission on application to the Local Medical Officer of your choice - as per attachment.

In the event of your place of residence being changed to another area, you should communicate with this office, as it may be necessary to make other arrangements for future treatment.

No responsibility will be accepted for payment of medical expenses incurred privately for the reason that you are now expected to avail yourself of the facilities afforded by the Commission.
