Provided that the Military Pay due to a deceased soldier does not exceed £100, it is not necessary to obtain Probate of the Will to receive payment. Should, however, it be desired to obtain Probate, the original Will may be obtained by the person entitled thereto upon application to this office. On probate being granted, it will be necessary that same be exhibited at this office for registration.

I have to further advise that until a Statement showing the position of the late soldier's account is received from the Staff Paymaster abroad, the balance of Pay and Deferred Pay cannot be paid over to the person legally entitled to the money.

A period of six months at least usually elapses after date of death before this Statement comes to hand, but immediately it is received you will be further communicated with.
