I was in hospital when you wrote to me & did not get your letter for some time, I am ~~not~~ <sup>out</sup> 23 days sick leave now, & staying with friends at Tumut.

I knew your husband, but I did not know him very well. I came on the first march from Sandakan to Ranau in Feb 45 & George came on the second march in June. When I escaped on the 7<sup>th</sup> July, he was still alive & well but like us all suffering badly from malnutrition.

Well Mrs Evans these things will happen, keep your chin up as you know George would want you too
