WILLIAM'S MOVEMENTS IN FRANCE...DECEMBER 1916 - FEBRUARY 1917

- 1. Joined the 4th Battalion in France from the UK at Bernafay Wood 20.12.1916...in support at Switch and Gap trenches near Flers...snow & mud
- 2. Spent a wet and windy Christmas Day in these same trenches 25.12.1916...this was to be William's last Christmas
- 3. Battalion relieved and proceeded to Coolgardie Camp at Meaulte 7.1.1917 then to Ribemont the next day
- 4. Battalion proceeded to Contay 13.1.1917
- 5. Battalion proceeded to Becourt 23.1.1917
- 6. Battalion moved into support trenches at Turk Lane and North Road 31.1.1917
- 7. Battalion relieved and marched to Fricourt Farm Camp 11.2.1917
- 8. Battalion marched to Albert 22.2.1917
- 9. Battalion proceeded to Bendigo Camp near Bazentin 25.2.1917
- 10. Battalion moved into frontline at Le Barque trench at Le Barque 27.2.1917
- 11. William seriously wounded at Le Barque trench & evacuated to 1st Field Ambulance at Bazentin-le-Petit where he died 2 hours later 28.2.1917
