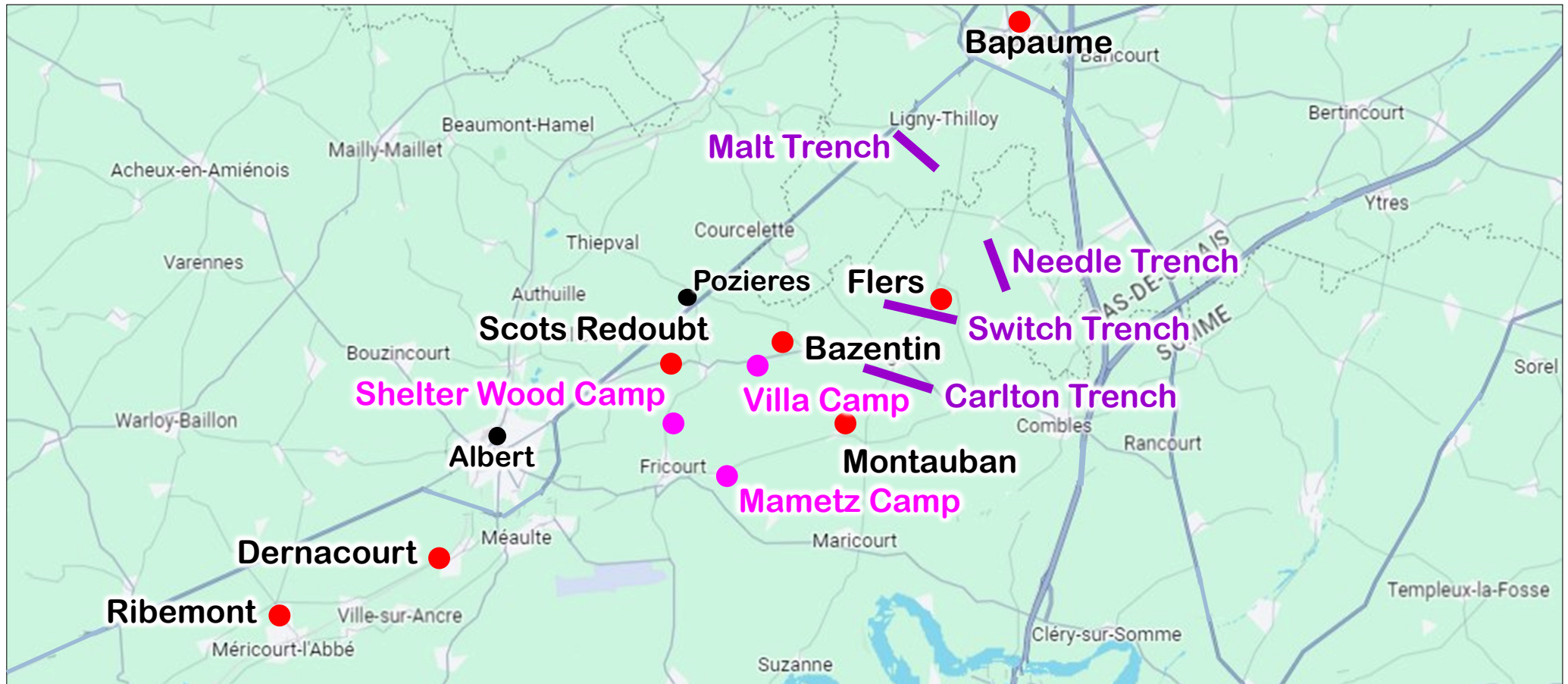


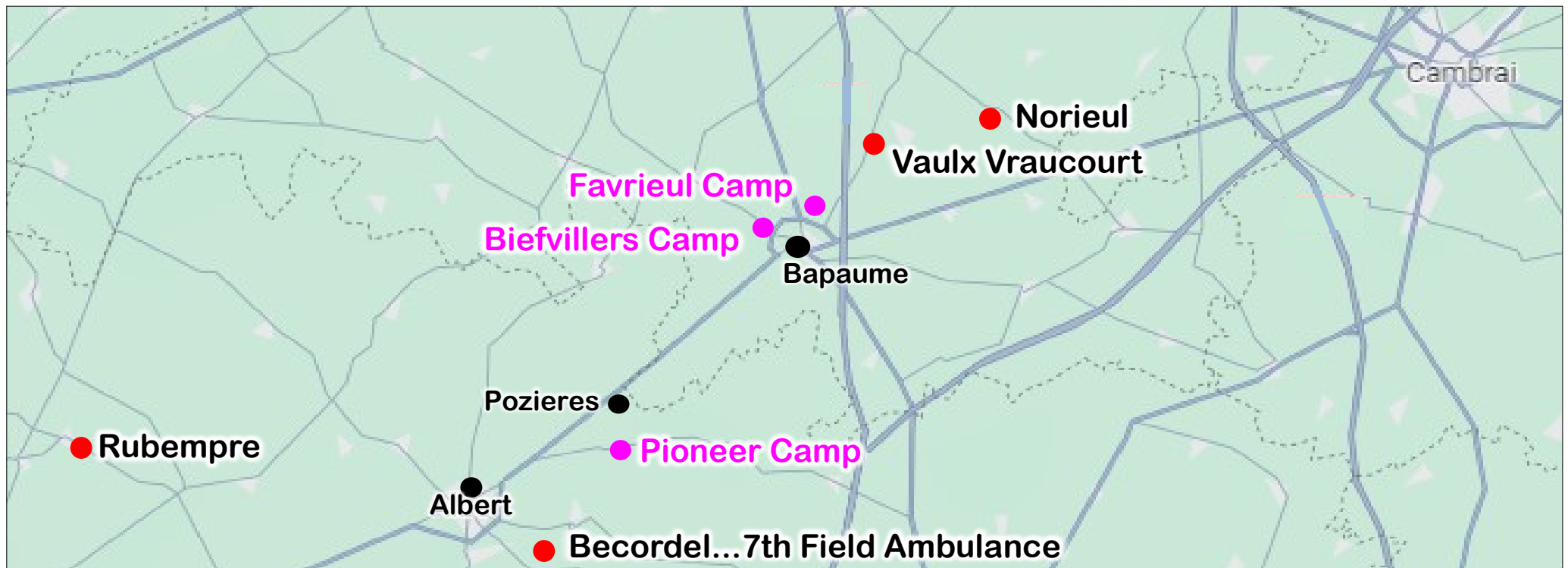
DUDLEY'S MOVEMENTS IN FRANCE...OCTOBER 1916 - MARCH 1917

- 26.10.16 Battalion arrived at Ribemont France from frontline trenches at Zillebeke in Belgium
- 6 & 7.11.16 Battalion moved to Montauban...in reserve in Switch trench near Flers
- 9.11.16 Battalion moved into frontline trenches in waist high mud then to Carlton trench south of Flers on the 13th
- 23.11.16 Battalion moved back to Ribemont
- 19.12.16 Battalion moved back to Montauban
- 21.12.16 Battalion moved into frontline at Switch and Needle trenches near Flers
- 16.1.17 Battalion moved to Dernacourt and then to Albert on the 29th
- 6.2.17 Battalion moved to Shelter Wood Camp then to Villa Camp on the 10th
- 19-26.2.17 Battalion moved to Scots Redoubt then to frontline and captured Malt trench on the 26th
- 5.3.17 Battalion moved to Bazentin then to frontline trenches on the 10th
- 20.3.17 Battalion moved to Bapaume then to Mametz Camp on the 29th to rest



DUDLEY'S MOVEMENTS IN FRANCE...APRIL - JUNE 1917

- 13.4.17 Battalion moved to trenches at Vraulx Vraucourt
- 20.4.17 Battalion moved to Favrieul Camp
- 1.5.17 Battalion moved to Norieul then back to Vraulx Vraucourt on the 3rd
- 5.5.17 Battalion moved to Biefvillers Camp then to Pioneer Camp on the 8th
- 18.5.17 Battalion moved to Rubempre
- 24.5.17 Dudley admitted to the 7th Field Ambulance at Becordel with defective vision
- 4.6.17 Dudley re-joined the Battalion at Rubempre
- 15.6.17 Battalion moved back to Biefvillers Camp



DUDLEY'S MOVEMENTS IN FRANCE & BELGIUM JULY 1917 - MARCH 1918

- 30.7.17 Battalion moved to Arques from Biefvillers Camp near Bapaume
- 12.9.17 Battalion moved to Steenvoorde then to Dickebusch Belgium
- 14.9.17 Battalion arrived at Ypres Belgium on the 14th to take part in the 3rd Battle of Ypres
- 20.9.17 Battalion moved to frontline trenches at Westhoek
- 23.9.17 Battalion moved to Halifax Camp to rest then to Dallington Camp on the 25th & Montreal Camp on the 29th
- 1.10.17 Dudley admitted to 7th Field Ambulance at Waratah Camp with a fever of unknown origin
- 7.10.17 Dudley re-joined the Battalion east of Ypres
- 9.10.19 Battalion took part in the Battle of Poelcappelle
- 12.10.17 Battalion took part in the Battle of Passchendaele
- 13.10.17 Battalion moved to billets at Le Temple
- 25.10.17 Battalion moved to Dickebusch then to Ypres on the 28th
- 2.11.17 Battalion moved into the frontline trenches
- 8.11.17 Battalion moved to Steenvoorde then to Wallon-Cappel
- 18.11.17 Battalion moved to Outtersteene then to Waterlands Camp near Armentieres
- 8.2.18 Dudley took leave and re-joined the Battalion at Bayenghem on 8.2.18
- 14-31.3.18 Battalion moved to Le Touquet, Le Rossignol then to Kortepyp and Wulvergem in Belgium



DUDLEY'S MOVEMENTS IN FRANCE...APRIL - SEPTEMBER 1918

- 5.4.18 Battalion moved from Belgium to Blangy Tronville in France and into the frontline the next day
- 7.4.18 Battalion moved to Hangard Wood and took part in the action there
- 10.4.18 Battalion moved to Boves and into the frontline on the 14th
- 18.4.18 Battalion moved to Querrieu
- 21.4.18 Battalion moved to Warloy then into the frontline on the 27th
- 2.5.18 Battalion moved to Frechencourt then to Cardonette on the 5th and Lahoussoye on the 10th and into the frontline
- 15.6.18 Battalion moved to Rivery
- 1.7.18 Battalion in reserve at Villers Switch trench
- 4.7.18 Battalion took part in the Battle of Hamel
- 7.7.18 Battalion moved into frontline at Vaire Wood
- 2.8.18 Battalion moved to Blangy Tronville
- 17.8.18 Battalion moved to Fouilloy
- 21-23.8.18 Battalion took part in the Battle of Albert
- 31.8.18 Battalion moved into the frontline and took part in the Battle of Mont St Quentin
 Dudley was wounded in the left leg & chest & admitted to 9th Field Ambulance at Chipilly then transferred to the 37th Casualty Clearing Station at Vecquemont before being evacuated to 9th General Hospital at Rouen on 1.9.1918 & then to England on 5.9.18 & admitted to Royal Victoria Hospital at Netley
