Septua- Sunday 1 ☺

Awoke at 7.30 am and went to 8.0 o'clock mass. Saw Mary Hanrahan - the picnic for to-day is off.

I dropped in to see Thelma at 12.30 pm and had to get her out of bed.

I took her out to Dover Heights to Britz's - Des and Ditha were there. We walked down and saw Bondi Beach, - all barbed wire. We arrived home about 10.0 - I arr. home 2.0 am.

FEBRUARY 1942

Purification Monday 2 Candlemas  
(Scot. Qr. Day)

About 10 am when I awoke. Took a few photos of the colour charts on Kodak Panchrom XX.

Went in to town this afternoon - had a haircut, bought ticket to Narramine and booked seat, paid instalment on typewriter, book a few school books - lodged a return of steel drums on hand.

Mary Hanrahan and I went in to see Trial by Jury and Pirates of Penzance. Blackout to-night 9.30 - 10.30

FEBRUARY 1942

Tuesday 3

Awoke about 11.0 am  
and found I was only  
one at home. Margaret  
commenced school, Barbara  
is still at work and Mum  
had gone up the street  
- sorted out some books.  
On counting up the titles  
of all my books as entered  
in an exercise book, I find  
that I have about 400 books  
- of all kinds - excluding  
magazines and periodicals.

Went up to Hanrahan's  
to-night.

FEBRUARY 1942

Wednesday 4

Arose about 9.0 am.  
Did a bit of reading  
to-day.  
Thelma and I went  
in to Prince Edward  
to-night and saw  
"Skylark" - not bad.

FEBRUARY 1942

Thursday 5

Ditha rang up this morning - I am to meet her and Des about 1.30 pm at Anthony Horderns.

Did some shopping - bought "Ways of Escape, Across the Frontiers", and "The Australian Aboriginal" - total £1-15-0.

Des, Ditha and I went to St James and saw Robt Taylor in "Billy the Kid".  
Thelma and I went in to Regent to-night and saw "Western Union".

FEBRUARY 1942

Friday 6

Arose about 8.30 am. Went up the street and did some shopping.

Packed my bags and then took one of them up to Maroochylle str and looked it through.

Thelma and I went over to Manly this to-night and wandered up the length of the beach to Nth Steyne. We arrived home about midnight. I arrived home about 2am.

FEBRUARY 1942

Saturday 7

Arose at 7.0 am, bathed, and then Joe drove Mum Barb and me into Central where I caught the Central Western Express at 8.30 am.

The train was packed. However I had a corner set and arrived safely in Narramine about 7.0 pm. Met Mrs McIntyre and Nettie at Dubbo - on their way to Orange.

I slept to-night at Lloyds.

FEBRUARY 1942

Sexagesima Sunday 8 €

Arose at 8.15 am and after breakfast went along to 9.0 am Mass.

Met Mr Rathbone and then wandered around all day. We arrived home about 7.30 pm.

There are only three of us here Doug Russell, Mr Rath. + myself - Eddie is in camp. Mrs P. and Billy have taken Snow to Orange.

Unpacked after tea.

FEBRUARY 1942

Monday 9

Crawled out about 9.0 am.  
Finished unpacking  
and tidied up the  
room. Wrote to Thelma  
this afternoon.

Did up some papers  
for Noel and Ray.

Quite warm to-day  
- about 102°.

Went to bed about  
11.0 pm.

FEBRUARY 1942

Tuesday 10

Reveille 7.30 am.  
Shaved, breakfasted,  
cut lunch, posted letters  
and arrived at school  
at 8.45 am.

~~There~~ Only 10 pupils  
returned this year.  
Snow. Nancy, Valda,  
Keith H. and Alan H  
have left.

Very warm - about  
102°.

FEBRUARY 1942

Wednesday 11

Cloudy and sultry to-day - showers around Peak Hill, but no rain fell here.

Drew up a new school time-table to-day.

Started kids covering exercise books.

Retired at 11.30pm.

FEBRUARY 1942

Thursday 12

Cloudy, hot and sultry. Stormy - reports of rain 1 inch 175 pts to 50 pts having fallen around Peak Hill but none here.

Collected the mail and called in to see Hartins this afternoon - the boys were cutting chaff.

Mowed the lawn this afternoon.

FEBRUARY 1942

Friday 13

We had about 9 points  
of rain this morning -  
I rode Charles to  
school - Thelma and  
Keith were the only  
absentees.

Preparing Lesson  
Register to-night.

FEBRUARY 1942

Saturday 14

7 points of rain fell  
early this morning -  
but then it fined up  
and we had quite a  
warm day. I gave  
Mr Rathbone a hand  
to feed the sheep  
this morning and  
then went with him  
this afternoon along the  
telephone line. I  
took several photos of  
trees carved by  
aboriginals. Had tea  
in Peak & then came  
home.

FEBRUARY 1942

Quinqua-  
gesima Sunday 15. ☺

Arose 7.0 am. did a few odd jobs - had breakfast. Went in to town for an all Day V.D.C. parade. The boys received their issues (tunic, slacks, boots, hats & gaiters). We went down to the river for Fieldcraft training.

We brought Jack Canan home this afternoon - he left his car in town for repairs.

FEBRUARY 1942

Monday 16

Quite warm to-day although cloudy. Full attendance at school.

I went down to Dawes but they were up the paddock - so I didn't wait. Wrote home to-night.

FEBRUARY 1942

Shrove  
Tuesday Tuesday 17

We had a few showers  
to-day - about 20 pts.  
Only the Hartlins were  
at school.

got wet coming home  
from school.

Received a letter from  
Thelma - to-day.

FEBRUARY 1942

Ash  
Wednesday Wednesday 18

Few showers - about  
15 points.

Full attendance  
at school.

FEBRUARY 1942

Thursday 19

Rained all day for  
50 points. Half-filled  
old tank. Full  
attendance.

Darwin was bombed  
last night

Saw a young eagle  
at about 40 yds -  
in a tree in the stock-  
route.

FEBRUARY 1942

Friday 20

Warm and fine -  
rain all gone - about  
1" for the week.  
Hilton Richardson  
came over about 2.45pm  
and finished off Keith's  
horse yard.

I rode over to  
Dawes after school.  
Leo is home again  
from Orange - he went  
after a job in munitions  
factory - not opening  
for a couple of months.

FEBRUARY 1942

Saturday 21

Arose about 8.30 am  
and after breakfast helped  
Leo feed the horses. I  
left for home about  
10.30 am. Took the  
centre bracket out of the  
bike & fixed up ball bearings.

Went in to Narronine  
with Mr R. Met  
Freya Hodges this  
afternoon.

Went to pictures  
with Dawes & Mr R. Eric  
Lampe was there.  
"Flight Command".

FEBRUARY 1942

Quadra-  
gesima Sunday 22 1st in  
Lent

Breakfasted about  
8.45 a. Helped  
feed the sheep and  
had a look at the back  
paddock. Took some  
meat down to Bert.  
Read all this  
afternoon.

Doug Russell went  
home yesterday afternoon  
and returned about  
6.30 to-day.

FEBRUARY 1942

Monday 23 3

Mrs Rathbone and Lorna came home to-night. Mr Rath. went in to Narramine to meet them.

FEBRUARY 1942

Tuesday 24

School as usual - posted a letter home and one to Thelma. also papers to Noel and Ray. Received roll of blue prints to-day. Mr Rathbone received a call up for examination

FEBRUARY 1942

Wednesday 25

Took Hoe, and raked to school to-day. Went over to Dawes' this afternoon to see if Tom Nash would come here to sow 100 acres of oats.

However he is too busy.

Mr Rathbone left for Sydney this afternoon— Doug Russell took him in.
