Frank Vendy



Trooper (Tpr) 502 Frank Vendy enlisted in the 4th Light Horse (LH) Regiment in the 4th Light Horse Brigade at Broadmeadows on 26 August 1914. He embarked overseas on 19 October and disembarked at Alexandria on 11 December.

Owing to the high number of battle and medical casualties sustained by the Australians, the 4th Light Horse arrived on Gallipoli (as infantry reinforcements) on 21 May 1915 and moved into the trenches at Courtney's Post two days later.

By 5 June 1915, the 4th LH was in the centre of the line facing German Officer's Ridge when they came under a heavy Turkish artillery bombardment which caused numerous casualties.

On 8 July, the regiment moved to the southern end of the line and established defensive positions around Ryrie's Post, and it was here on 21 July that Tpr Vendy sustained a gunshot wound that fractured his skull.

Evacuated to the 1st Australian Casualty Clearing Station later the same day, he was transferred to Malta and admitted to the Military Hospital at Valletta on 28 July but died of his wounds on 31 July 1915.

Trooper 502 Frank Vendy was subsequently buried at the Pieta Military Cemetery, Malta on 2 August 1915.
