Took part in landing at Gallipoli April 25th 1915, was in the second boat to land troops - He was last seen carrying down to shelter a wounded comrade whom he had bandaged. Was reported "missing" and later "killed in action" April 25th 1915.

He was a student of Conchology and had made a fine collection of shells, some of which were presented to and accepted by the British Museum.
