## **Edward John Hughes**

Private (Pte) 55639 Edward John Hughes enlisted in the 7<sup>th</sup> General (Victorian) Reinforcements in Melbourne on 29 March 1918.

He embarked overseas on 23 July and disembarked in London on 27 September where he joined the 1<sup>st</sup> Training Brigade at Fovant Camp.

Pte Hughes absented himself from camp without leave on 15 November and was apprehended by the Provost Corps (Military Police) in Bristol three days later. He was returned to camp and awarded seven days' Field Punishment (extra work duties) and docked 10 days' pay.

He left England on 28 January 1919 and landed in France the next day, where he was taken on strength of the 7<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion at Couillet on 2 February.

Two days later, he was detached for duty with the YMCA, which generally provided recreational facilities, entertainment, libraries and even religious services for the troops. He remained in this role until 13 May.



He returned to England on 16 May and then embarked for Australia on 23 July.

Private 55639 Edward John Hughes disembarked in Melbourne on 10 September, where he was discharged from the AIF on 25 September 1919.
