## **Clifford William Henry Barker**



Private (Pte) 55109 Clifford William Henry Barker enlisted in the 5<sup>th</sup> General (Victorian) Reinforcements at Geelong on 2 April 1918.

He embarked overseas on 5 June and disembarked in Liverpool, England on 11 August, where he was initially allotted to the 60<sup>th</sup> Battalion reinforcements at Codford Camp.

He was subsequently transferred to the 8<sup>th</sup> Battalion reinforcements at Hurdcott Camp on 2 October, then embarked for France on 22 November, where he was taken on strength of the 8<sup>th</sup> Battalion, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade of the 1<sup>st</sup> Australian Division, at Sars Poteries on 2 December 1918.

Pte Barker was detached for duty with the 1<sup>st</sup> Division Artillery Depot of Supply from 22 February – 13 May 1919, then returned to England on 24 May and embarked for Australia on 23 July.

Private 55109 Clifford William Henry Barker disembarked in Melbourne on 10 September, where he was discharged from the AIF on 25 September 1919.
