"Died of Wounds 11.11.17"

We were standing right together on top of hill 63 Nov.11th when a shell (5.9.) exploded behind us when we were standing at the floor of the dugout. It killed Love instantaneously. He was a great pal of mine. I would like to know his people's address. I was wounded at the same time. They would be buried in the cemetery $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile away from D.S.
