The only information available so far is that he was reported Missing, believed Killed on 29.1.42, no place being stated.



Witness States: When withdrawing round about the 30 mile post on 27th or 28th Jan. we were shelled. The troops scattered. Next morning Lt. Nisbett was missing. Major Stringer later told me that he had a conversation with some men from 2/30 Inf. Bn. who followed us and from what they had said he was satisfied that Nisbett had been killed and that his body was on the side of the road where we were shelled. He was posted by the Bn. "Missing believed Killed".
