With reference to your communication of the 11th June, which has been referred to this Office from Headquarters, 4th District Base, Keswick Barracks, Adelaide, S.A., I shall be much obliged if you will advise me whether the father of the late No. 1544 Private A.E. SHIPLEY, 10th Battalion, is also residing at the undermentioned address; if not will you kindly favor me with information as to his present whereabouts.

The information is necessary in keeping with the instructions under the Deceased Soldiers' Estates Act of 1918, which prescribe that War Medals, etc., must go to the next-of-kin in a certain order of relationship, the claims of a father being regarded before those of a mother, unless good and sufficient reasons for varying the procedure are stated for the consideration of the Minister. Of course, if Mr. Shipley no longer survives the Victory Medal and Memorial Plaque issuable on account of your son's service will be transmitted to you upon receipt of your advice to that effect. With reference to your communication of 26th November I very much regret to inform you that an exhaustive search has been made by the Graves Units over the vicinity in which your son, the late No. 1544 Private A.E. Shipley, 10th Battalion, was originally buried, but unfortunately no trace of his grave can be located. Presumably this is owing to the surface markings having been obliterated by shell fire during later engagements.

Where the authorities fail to recover and identify the actual remains, it is the intention of the Imperial War Graves Commission to suitably perpetuate the memory of the missing by the erection of collective memorials in certain defined battle areas, and on which will be inscribed the full regimental description and date of death of the soldiers concerned.
