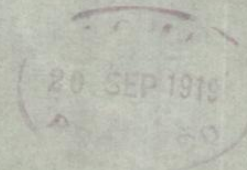


A special branch of the Adjutant-General's Department of
