It was he, who, after his platcon commander had been hit, reorganised the platoon and thus enabled it to go forward as an organised body. During the enemy barrage he went about in the open directing the men to dig in and showing stretcher bearers where wounded lay, all the time being exposed to heavy enemy shell fire and showing an absolute disregard for same.
