

1. I refer to your letter received at this office on 22 November 1989.
2. The Pacific Star was awarded for one days service in an operational zone of the South West Pacific Area between 8 December 1941 and 2 September 1945.
3. Records held by this office indicate that your late husband did not serve in this zone and therefore was not eligible for the award of the Pacific Star.
4. It is pointed out that temporary authority issued for the wearing of the ribbon of an award did not constitute an authority for the award itself, as in all cases, the award is only issued by this office after establishment of an entitlement to the award.
5. According to our records ex VX17392 Warrant Officer Class Two Maurice Joseph Walsh qualified for and was issued with the 1939/45 Star, Africa Star, Defence Medal, War Medal and Australia Service Medal. This was his full entitlement.
6. I regret to inform you that a replacement Returned from Active Service Badge can only be issued to the original recipient.


