21st of August 1915
Went in to Camps 1st Sept
Nothing of much interest
Took place up till 30th
of Sept when I
volunteered to sail
in four days time with the 10th of 9th Bn

Fraser's Camp. Squad Drill
Oct 1st: Musketry Course at Enoggera Range
Farewell Dance to unit at Temperance Hall
Oct 2nd: Squad Drill & Bayonet Exercise
Went to a send-off at Windsor School of Arts
Oct 3rd: Musketry Course as Previous
Oct 4th: Bayonet Exercise & Muster Parade.
Received presentations of a wallet
and wristlet watch. Letter from
Brothers of Native Rose Lodge. E W O F
Oct 5th: Left Fraser's Camp for
Enoggera Station. Boarded train to

27
Pinkenba and Embarked on H.M.S.
"Warilda" for Egypt. Numerous
friends came to give us a farewell
Left at 5 P.M.

Oct 7th: Sighted Sydney Heads about 10 A.M.
Entered Sydney Harbour 1 P.M. and
anchored in Watson's Bay awaiting
Doctor. Later proceeded to Garden
Island Beach & anchored awaiting
N.S.W. Troops

Oct 8th: New South Wales Troops embarked
and had a good send off. Left at
5 P.M. for Fremantle

Oct 14th: Very rough weather
round Cape Leeuwin. 2 days off
Fremantle

Oct 15th: Arrived at Fremantle at 4 P.M.
and had a good reception. On
guard for 1½ hours

Went up to Perth for a few hours
and had a very good time. Came
back to Fremantle & went for a
tram ride. Had tea and went to a
dance. & had a good time. Returned
to ship at 10.30 P.M.

St Pierre-au-Lawray 10.15 AM. Rocen

12.15 AM Muetot 1.45 PM Arrived at Havre.

4 PM. disentrained & walked to camp 4 miles

for horses. Thursday preparations
for moving near to firing line
Left Havre at 9.0. arrived Abbeville
9.15 AM next morning 16th inst Nogelles
9.35 AM Rue. 10.20 AM Etaples 11.45 AM
Boulogne 12.30 PM. Calais 1.45 PM. St Omer
2.15 PM Caestre 4.0 PM detrained watered
horses. at farm house I went to billet in
Centre of village of Caestre

 Violent bombardment during night

July 19th: Big battle on our front 4 lines
 of trenches Taken & lost again heavy
 casualties of Australians. Aeroplane
 fell near by

July 21st: Shells bursting very close
 to billets

July 23rd: Moved to Armentieres arrived
 12.30 & camped in Cotton Spinning Mill

Band playing in one part of town. Air
 raging on the other side 7.30 PM

Went round town viewing ruins
 of Church & other buildings met a
 few New Zealanders & had a good time

July 25th: Received 12 letters. Moved to 41st Battery lines

July 26th: Went in to Armentieres

July 27th: Nothing doing during day
Gas alarm at night

July 28th: Nieppe town area & station
bombarded.

July 29th: Went to Armentieres for mail
Had a look through Spinning Mill

Nieppe

few casualties. Went to H.Q. in
Armentieres received letter & parcel from
England.

August 1st: Very hot. Went in to Nieppe
& had a look at damage done by bombardment
Went to Pictures at Pont. Nieppe

Aug 2nd: Took horses out for exercise. Had a
swim in R. Lys in evening. Walked to
41st Big Gun pits through Armentieres arrived
home 9.15 PM

Aug 3rd: Exercising horses.

through Estaires. Newville halted for dinner
1 1/2 hours. Passed outskirts of Hazebrouck
bivouaced for night near Wallon - Cappel

pretty. Camped for dinner on banks of
La-Dessee Canal. Continued journey 12-30
through Au. St. Sebastian. Equestre arrived
at Lombres 5 PM & went into good billets
off town square.

a raid. Germans bombarding them heavily

and saw old mate. ON picquet

Raining all day Arrived back 6.30 PM

Sept 6th: Went out to 41st & 2nd & 3rd Btys

Sept 7th: Went to 110th & 48th Bty W. L's
and to A.S.C. Lines and Westoutre

Sept 8th: Went out to 48th Bty
afternoon out to Westoutre

Sept 9th: up to 44th W.L's and to Poppinghe
to 2nd D.A.C

Sept 10th: Went to 2nd D.A.C. 947th Btn. ONPAT

Sept 27th: German aeroplane pursued by
British but escaped. Later ~~observed~~ observation
balloon got away and was brought down by aeroplane

Sept 28th & 29th ; went down to Boeschepe

14th Proceeded on journey passing Goedeswalde, Mi-des-Cats, Fletre, Strazele, View-Berquin camped at Veaf-Berquin for one night. Reviewed during journey by Generals Cox and Rosenthal.

15th Continued on passing through Merville, St Venant Camped on La. Bassee Canal for lunch. Continued journey through Busnes, **Lillers**.

Camped at Lieres for one night

Nov 16th Moved off 8 AM through Ames Amettes, Fezay, Aumerwal, Pernes Valhuon, La Thiéloye, Camped at Monehy-Breton for the night

Nov 17th Moved off 8 AM through Bailieu-aux-Cornailles, Naxieres, Averdoingt, Magnicourt-sur-Cense, Conettment Rebrevue, and camped at Rebrevette for the night very cold during the night. Saw snow for first time.

Nov 18th Continued on passing Oboque maison, Haut-Disse (Dullens City)

Amplier and camped at Orville for the night. In piequel

Nov 19th Proceeded on journey passing through Authole, Beaurval, Falmas; and camped at Villers-Pocage.

Nov 20th Proceeded on journey back through Falmas to Xaours till orders to move.

Nov 22nd Went to Wagnies to A.A.C

Nov 24th Went to Vignacourt through Wagnies & Havernes

Nov 25th Went to Field Service Dump

Nov 27th Went to Vignacourt with sick reports & Wagnies.
