DEATH OF PRIVATE REGINALD EWBANK CARGEEG

23 February 1921

The Australian (Perth, WA) reported on Friday 4 March 1921 that the late Reg E. Cargeeg died recently in hospital while undergoing his eighth operation for a wound (severe thigh wound) received at Gallipoli. His brother was killed in action while taking part in the historic Landing with the Eleventh Battalion. Both were sons of Mr. G.H. Cargeeg, of Parry-street, Claremont.
