**RAAF Wing Commander Andrew Layton, Commanding Officer 29 Squadron / Senior Air Force Officer-Tasmania was on King Island last week to take part in Remembrance Day.**

On behalf of the Chief of Air Force, WGCDR Layton took the opportunity to pay respect to the crew who died 68 years ago on the 11th of July 1943 at 2.00am, when their Beaufort aircraft crashed, just 1.5km north east of the Currie aerodrome.
