

On 14th August 1916 at 12.30 p.m. at Pozieres, he, one other name whose name he forgets, and Snell were going back along a communication trench, when a piece of shell hit Snell on the back of his head and killed him immediately. Informant says they had to leave him where he was hit.

He was hit in the head by a piece of ahrapsel at Pozieres on Aug.14th. His body was placed outside the trench to sweit buriel. Sgt.J.Good, B.Coy, 51st.Bn, saw the casualty, and could give eye-witness details of it. He gave me the facts as I have stated them. I sent this information to his people.
