#### **CASUALTY NOTIFICATION:**

Flight Lieutenant Hanson was in the crew of Liberator A72-92, which crashed at position ARCEAST FIRE 01.18N 124.51E during low level photography of the vicinity of Tomohon Village, North East Celebes. The aircraft was located in a position approximately two miles bearing 150 degrees Tomohon Village and appeared to have hit the ground at a very shallow angle on a downward slope and then crossed a small depression and up another small rise. There were not signs of SURVIVORS. (THREE CREW SURVIVED THE CRASH BUT WERE KILLED BY THE JAPANESE)
