

In reply to your letter, undated, I have to state the cable message received here regarding No. 45 Private T. Chatburn. 43rd Battalion, contained no other information than that he is wounded, (2nd occasion).

His case is not reported as serious. however, and it is to be assumed in the absence of any later news, he is progressing favourably, the practice of the overseas authorities being to notify the Department of any serious change in condition.






